



## Photobooks: In Circulation

a free webinar series about photobooks!

The program is organised by Johannes Romppanen and [Aalto Photography](#). In partnership with [Utopias Lahti](#) and [Photobooks from Finland](#), in collaboration with [Reflektor](#) and [bookRoom](#).

A photobook is not just a collection of photographs – it is a form of thinking in constant flux. We invite three speakers who work with photographic publications as a form of interconnected media. This year, the program concentrates on the nordics, with speakers from Finnish, Swedish and Danish scenes. Each guest will share their practice, with a focus on sustainable and circular modes of production and the social practices taking place around publications. Each session consists of a talk followed by a Q&A discussion with the audience.

### **Sauli Sirviö**

Sauli Sirviö's artistic practice is grounded in fieldwork and archiving. His archives consist of publications, photographs, and an extensive collection of found artefacts. In December 2024, he published Archiving 'en plein air' (Utu Press), which was selected for the Finnish Book Art Committee's "Beautiful Books of the Year 2024" -collection.

### **Karl Larsson**

Karl Larsson is a multidisciplinary artist whose practice intersects photography, archival activism, and independent publishing. Since 2003, he has amassed The Million Project—an unprecedented archive of over two million photographs documenting the structures of everyday life. This monumental body of work serves as the engine for PUUT –Publicering & Utlåning, a nomadic artist's book library initiated in 2018.

### **Julia Mejnertsen**

Julia Mejnertsen is a Copenhagen-based artist whose work explores family mythologies. Through her practice, she unravels the intricate stories and narratives that shape our familial connections, revealing the profound impact they have on our identities and perceptions of self. Mejnertsen is a founder of Blankt Papir press, a nano-publishing house specialising in handmade, limited edition artist photobooks.
